Developing and Expanding the Pharmacist's Role in Patient Care

Our residents are fully integrated as providers of high-quality patient care in a variety of settings:

Acute Care

Although residents are based in the Portland, Medford, and Newberg/Milwaukie areas, they benefit from the knowledge of more than 170 full-time pharmacists across eight acute-care facilities in Oregon. Together, residents and pharmacy teams provide a broad scope of progressive pharmacy services, including pharmacist-managed collaborative drug management.

Ambulatory Care

Our primary care clinical pharmacy specialists provide disease management and collaborative drug therapy management to Providence Medical Group patients in the medical home setting. The department also supports clinical pharmacy involvement within anticoagulation clinics, medication assistance programs, and population health. Our ElderPlace clinical pharmacy specialists provide care for the frail elderly and collaborate across multiple clinic settings.

Home Services/Infusion

Our home services/infusion pharmacists provide both medication dispensing and clinical management of neonatal, pediatric, adult, and geriatric patients receiving infusion therapies such as antimicrobial therapy, TPN, and specialty medications.

Specialty Pharmacy (Credena Health)

Our specialty pharmacists are engaged and proactive in the management of specialty medications across 49 states and serve as drug information specialists for both patients and providers. Pharmacists perform initial and on-going patient assessments to evaluate the appropriateness of drug therapy regimens, assess adherence and address side effect concerns of patients on specialty drug regimens.

Providence Health Plan

Our pharmacists develop a solid foundation in population-based pharmaceutical care. Primary emphasis is placed on the development and implementation of medication use management initiatives and policies, formulary management, and quality and outcome assessment in collaboration with the health-system and the Pharmacy & Therapeutics Committee. In addition, our medication therapy management pharmacists provide direct patient care to ensure safe and efficacious drug therapy for our elderly patients.

Compensation and Benefits

Resident salaries throughout Providence in Oregon are competitive with other residency programs throughout the Pacific Northwest. Residents qualify for Providence employee benefits, including medical, dental and vision coverage with a variety of plans available and a flexible spending account. Your spouse and dependents also are eligible for coverage. Providence offers life insurance, retirement plans, and a matching program for retirement.
