



Call for OSHP 2021 Virtual Annual Seminar Posters

OSHP invites all members to submit a poster for presentation during the 2021 Annual Virtual Seminar. This is a great opportunity to display your initiatives and share ideas. We all want to see the great work you are doing, so why not take the opportunity to develop a poster!

The poster session will be **held on Saturday, May 1st, 2021**. Poster presentation details (setup, display time and Zoom access) will be forwarded to presenters at a later date.

Projects do not have to be complete; they can be still in the implementation phase or just starting. If you do not have any data yet, do not let that keep you away. Describe the project goals and aims... results can come later!

OSHP poster session utilizes guidelines similar to those of ASHP and ACCP. **For participation in the poster session, abstracts should be submitted to the OSHP Annual seminar poster planning committee by Friday, March 5th.** Poster abstracts will be reviewed, and **presenters notified by Friday, March 12th**, seven weeks prior to the seminar. If we receive more abstracts than available spaces, we will review and select abstracts based on applicability to OSHP member practices. The abstract guidelines and format are attached below.

NEW THIS YEAR! Annual Seminar will be virtual! What does this mean for those who will be submitting poster abstracts?

- Live online presentations during the virtual seminar through breakout rooms
- Presenters will be required to submit online materials for the virtual event website as well as a 5–10-minute prerecorded poster presentation.

Posters are presented in two categories: students and practitioners/residents. Prizes for first, second, and third place will be awarded in each category.

Personnel Category (Check appropriate category)

Student Practitioner/Resident
