On behalf of Pacific University and Oregon State University SSHP, we would like to request eight complimentary registrations for the upcoming OSHP Fall and Annual Seminar. Our goal is to provide complimentary registrations to the current executive members (6 from Pacific University and 2 from OSU). With complimentary registrations, we hope to encourage executive members to participate in these valuable seminars.

To establish the importance of attending OSHP Fall and Annual Seminar, the Pacific University ASHP/SSHP executive team created a survey to collect experiences, feedback, and tips from Pacific University pharmacy students who attended OSHP Annual Seminar 2019. The responses reflected an overall positive experience. The most common reasons for students attending were to network, present research projects, support peers' presentations, and learn more about the pharmacy profession. When asked about the most significant takeaway from the seminar, students commonly replied that it was an invaluable opportunity to network with both students and pharmacists, to learn new topics from the poster session, and to stay up-to-date with the offered educational sessions throughout the day. One student even noted a desire to volunteer during the next seminar and underscored the impact of OSHP on the pharmacy profession. We plan to continue to collect feedback from students post-seminar in order to facilitate optimizing the student pharmacist experience.

Providing complimentary registration for each of the executive teams, not only allows student representatives to participate in the seminars without a financial burden, but it also rewards them for their year-long contributions to their respective school's SSHP chapter. In exchange for the complimentary registrations, each of the participants would become dedicated volunteers and facilitate the visions of the planning committee.
